It is easy to order. The Book Club LOOP platform for parents allows you to pay by credit card. Your child's order is submitted directly to Scholastic and the books will be delivered to your child's school. ### 2020 Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC) – Important update 15 April 2020

The Premier's Reading Challenge is run for students in Kindergarten – Year 9. Some of the reading rules have been changed for 2020. The main change is that students can now read 10 free choice books instead of 5. This will make completing the challenge a little easier at home as you are not restricted to PRC books.
