Dear Parent/Guardian,

Mamre Anglican School is excited to be participating in the Premier's Reading Challenge (PRC) again this year.

Children from K-2 will have 30 books from the PRC Challenge read to them by their classroom/library teacher. Teachers will monitor the books that they have read and log them online to complete the challenge for all the K-2 children. The PRC may be completed at home by students in Years 3 – 9 and parents are asked to monitor and log their child's reading. Books read each night as part of the PRC may also be recorded for their Home Reading Log (K-6).

Students from Years 3 – 9 should have been given a Recording Sheet to record the books they have read. Alternatively, students may log books directly onto the PRC website. Students need to read 20 books.

Children may read books at a higher level in the Challenge. Full booklists, rules, and conditions are available on the NSW Premier's Reading Challenge website as well as the place to log your child's completed books <https://products.schools.nsw.edu.au/prc/booklist/home.html>

Students in Years 3-9 have been given their usernames and passwords in class.

At the completion of the challenge, all students who have achieved a Participation or Gold Award (4 Years Completion) will receive these during Chapel in Term 4. Platinum Awards (7 Years Completion) and Medals (completed the PRC every year from Year 3 to 9 inclusive) receive their awards during Presentation Events in December.

If your child has completed the PRC previously at another school, please contact Library staff with student name and previous school name – this ensures your child receives any awards they are eligible for.

The Library will be coordinating the PRC this year. If you have any questions, please feel free to email Library staff at library@mamre.nsw.edu.au and we'd be happy to assist you.
