General Uniform Rules for Mufti Days

Students must adhere to the following rules on 'Mufti Days'

- Students should tie hair back for practical lessons
- Students may wear jewellery, but no 'dangling' earrings (WHS) or large hoop earrings

The following rules must also be followed to ensure all students feel comfortable and safe. Child Protection and modesty provide the framework for our non-uniform rules.

- ALL students must wear fully enclosed shoes, preferably lace up. Sandals, Rabens, Thongs or any other type of slip-on or canvas type shoes are not permitted. It is essential that if students have any practical lessons including Food Tech, Timber Tech, Metal Tech, or Science they MUST bring their leather lace up school shoes to change into for that lesson. If students have PE they must bring their normal sports shoes to participate in the lesson.
- No SHORT shorts
- Shirts and tops must not contain any offensive material and should not be see through.
- No crop tops or singlets for boys or girls
